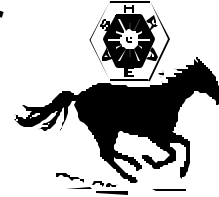

The Bluegrass Chapter Awards it's First Scholarship

In the fall of 2002, ASHRAE lost one of its greatest and dearest supporters, Mr. Donald T. MacClellan. Mr. MacClellan tirelessly served ASHRAE at the Chapter, Regional, and Society Level. He has served as President of the Bluegrass Chapter (on more than one occasion) and he wrote the chapter on Cogeneration in the Systems Handbook. In addition, Mr. MacClellan has served on various Society Level Technical Committees. Mr. MacClellan has been credited with starting the Mountaineer Chapter upon recognizing a void in serving the Eastern Kentucky and Western West Virginia members.

At the word of his passing, the Bluegrass Chapter decided to launch a Scholarship Program in his honor. A scholarship in the amount of \$500 will be awarded each year to a graduating senior entering a technical discipline at an institution of higher learning. A committee made up of David Derse, Angela Penn and Anthony Wright was commissioned to establish a procedure and begin the scholarship program. All Fayette County Public Schools were contacted and were asked to find candidates for the scholarship meeting the established criterion.

Three very strong candidates were evaluated and **Mr. Joshua Franks of Lafayette High School** earned the scholarship for the 2002-03 school year. The Bluegrass chapter will announce Mr. Franks as the successful recipient during Lafayette's May 20, 2003 Awards Ceremony held in Beeler Auditorium. Mrs. Bess MacClellan, the widow of Donald MacClellan, has been asked to be on hand to award the first scholarship to Joshua Franks. This is history for our chapter and the leadership of the board is to be commended.

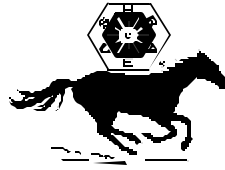
